

Facial Aesthetic Treatments (Dermaplaning, HydraFacial, Chemical Peels, other Facial Treatment)

Facial Aesthetic Pre-Treatment Instructions

- Avoid sun exposure, waxing, peels, or any other aggressive exfoliating facial treatments (glycolic, enzymes) for at least one week prior to treatment.
- Avoid OTC acne medications (Benzoyl Peroxide, Salicylic) for 48 hours
- Avoid topical prescription medications (Retin-A, Tazorac, Differin, EpiDuo,etc) for 48 hrs
- Treatment area cannot have an active herpes breakout, open wounds or infection
- Must not have had any medium/deep chemical or ablative/non ablative laser treatments within the past month prior to treatment
- Must wait 14 days after receiving Botulinum toxin and 1 month after Dermal Fillers to receive treatment
- You must notify us,
 - o if you have taken Accutane within the last 6 months, as you cannot be treated
 - if you are on any medications (topical and/or oral), have any medical conditions, or are being treated by a physician for any conditions or any changes in your medications, medical history, or new or existing allergies, or are undergoing cancer treatment, or if you are taking any cancer medications.
 - if you are prone to or cold sores or herpes simplex as you may be recommended to take Valtrex, which may be taken starting 1-2 days before.
 - If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, please inform us as we will choose only a treatment that is safe during this time.

Facial Aesthetic Post-Treatment Instructions

- Use a gentle cleanser and apply moisturizer at least twice daily for a minimum of 7 days post treatment.
- Avoid sun exposure after treatment and apply Sunscreen SPF 50 with Zinc or Titanium
- Avoid excessive heat 3 days post treatment if possible, i.e. heavy workouts, steam/sauna
- Avoid facial waxing for at least 10 days.
- Do not pick, scratch, or aggressively rub the treated area. No scrubs, polishers, or aggressive brushes should be used for 7 to 14 days.
- You may experience slight peeling or slight wind burn sensation is normal for the first few days. Skin care products may tingle or slightly burn as well.
